




2. Objectives of the initiative


With the vision of sustainable CF management, enable CF management committees and forestry administration staffs to develop principles and tools for monitoring the development of CF organizations and evaluating their quality

3.1. Selecting the CF organizations




3.2. Designing the M&E framework: a three level approach

- ⇒ To provide quantitative data be used as a basis for comparison with future situations
- ⇒ To analyze the evolution of the CF performance (strength and weaknesses)

- ⇒ To identify issues specific to each CF performance

- ⇒ The field tool-book provides the CF stakeholders with an evidence-based appreciation of the community forest and its social organization.

4. Lessons learnt

- ⇒ Sustainability of Community Forestry Management is adequately detailed and assessed as a quality-oriented process using PCI framework
- ⇒ The proposed M&E framework constitutes a management tool that comprehensively addresses CF development and quality
- ⇒ The proposed M&E framework is an efficient communication tool between CF stakeholders
- ⇒ M&E process should be initiated at the beginning of the CF development
- ⇒ M&E concepts are difficult to grasp: strong need for committed facilitators during all phases of the process
- ⇒ The M&E process is an efficient medium for capacity building
- ⇒ Sustainability depends on commitment of local FA staffs
