This General Assembly was chaired for the last time by President Dr. B. Alpern, founding member and first General Secretary of the CIMP from 1958 to 1967. Dr. B. Alpern who is now completely oriented towards Coal Petrology, wanted to retire from CIMP Presidency.

Participants have allowed the Executive Committee to vary with a rather long accepted usage to elect CIMP officers during General Assembly. Consequently, a postal ballot has been organized early 1976.

General informations on next CIMP activities were given and agreements obtained on the outline of the Secretary General Report which was presented to the main Congress on Saturday 13th September 1975, morning. See this text elsewhere in Moscow Congress Compte-Rendu.
