

Objective

- Build a programme to help independent researchers enhance their leadership, management and engagement
- Focus: progress from where they are now to where they want to be





A bottom-up approach

- Setting up of a Focus Group:
- Research Office Director
- Vice-Deans Research
- Pl's

Strength: interdisciplinarity

- Objectives:
- Forum to showcase and discuss the materials (online courses)
- Working group to identify the needs of researchers and build appropriate workshops





A blended format

- Online courses designed by Epigeum to provide participants materials developed through collaboration of experts from international universities
- A portfolio to bring self-reflection
- "Classroom workshop" to give participants the chance to learn from mentors and share their own experiences

"Courses raise questions, workshops provide answers"





Programme

- 5 modules:
- Developing and consolidating your research career
- Funding your research
- Managing a research team
- Research collaboration
- Communicating your research





Target Group

- Early- and mid-career researchers
- New permanent staff

- "Vertically homogeneous" : uniform status
- "Horizontally heterogeneous": diverse fields of research





Follow-up

- Successful pilot cohort becoming sponsor of the project
- Programme officially launched in October 2018, sized to last 6 months
- Monitoring and evaluation to make
