Collaboration?



Pharmacist

- Must be financially compensated
- Home care nurse or family member preparing a weekly pillbox entails a risk
- In favor of collaboration
- Would optimize the control of risks related to drug interactions and self-medication



Home care nurse

- Would allow her/himself to refine her/his knowledge
- Could optimize the control of risks associated with self-medication and drug interactions
- Would simplify the organization in terms of inventory management
- In favor of this collaboration if it is established with a sharing of fees and tasks

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
