
# Meuse river...became a channel

A long, straight & monotonous waterline  
that cuts the opened fields as a glittering sword !



## Meuse and Landscape changed

- boundaries became smooth
- course became linear and smooth too
- islands disappeared
- water and land lost their capricious and dynamics characters giving sites and cities roughness, materiality and identity .





City tends to enchain the indocile flow of water;  
River tends to break the rigidity,  
to move and modify itself,  
to make its relationship with the city  
undefined and inconstant.

Reconciling the indocile mobility of the river  
with the geometry of urban spaces  
is not an easy operation:  
**one or the other inevitably tends to prevail**
