Exploring the Sublime in the Contemporary American Memoir: Thoreau's Legacy and the Case of Native Alaska

Tuesday, Nov. 29, 2022 3:30 p.m. Atwood Library Calhoun 300 David Lombard is a research fellow at the Belgian National Fund for Scientific Research (FNRS), and a PhD candidate in literary studies at the Universities of Liège and Leuven.

This talk will assess the affordances and limits of the sublime for representing human-non-human relationships in Ernestine Hayes' *Blonde Indian* (2006) and Ken Ilgunas' *Walden on Wheels* (2013), which alternate between mobilizations of the natural sublime and the "haptic sublime" (McNee 2016) in their descriptions of the Alaskan landscape.
