# 1. Research context


- *Background*

Bavière (Liège, Be) and Le Champ des Possibles (Montréal, Ca)






A diversity of images, memories, geographies, symbols and values.

→ How can we grasp a place's social imaginaries?  
Exploration of different theoretical corpus







## 2. Three distant conceptual corpus

### A. Anthropology of Enchantment

- Voluntary Suspension of Disbelief x “Je sais bien mais quand même” (*As If*)
- Dispositives and dispositions (Winkin 2023)
- Engineers of enchantment

Problem: place only understood as spatial




Maybe you are going to do bad things. We don't know.

## 2. Three distant conceptual corpus

### B. Place, Place Studies and humanistic geography

- Place: “intersection entre un espace abstrait qui le contient et un objet dont il est l'emplacement” (Debarbieux 1993, 6)
- Humanistic geography: a refusal to positivism
- “Sense of place” (Tuan 1979) - Sensitive approach

Problem: became depoliticized/relativistic

Anecdote of the jar - Wallace Stevens, oct. 1919

I placed a jar in Tennessee,

Like nothing else in Tennessee.


## 2. Three distant conceptual corpus

### C. Social Imaginaries within political philosophy

- “ [...] création incessante et essentiellement indéterminée (social-historique et psychique) de figures/formes/images, à partir desquelles seulement il peut être question de “quelque chose”. (Castoriadis 1975, 8)
- Radical theory of creation pushing towards autonomy
- Imaginary as a social and political dimension


Problem: broad philosophical perspective  
→ Operationalization and spatiality ?


