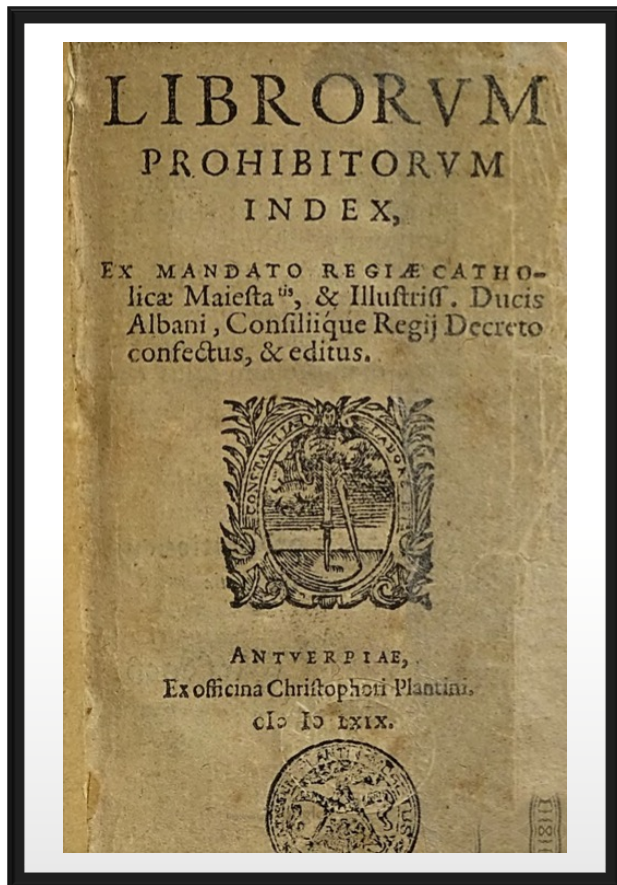

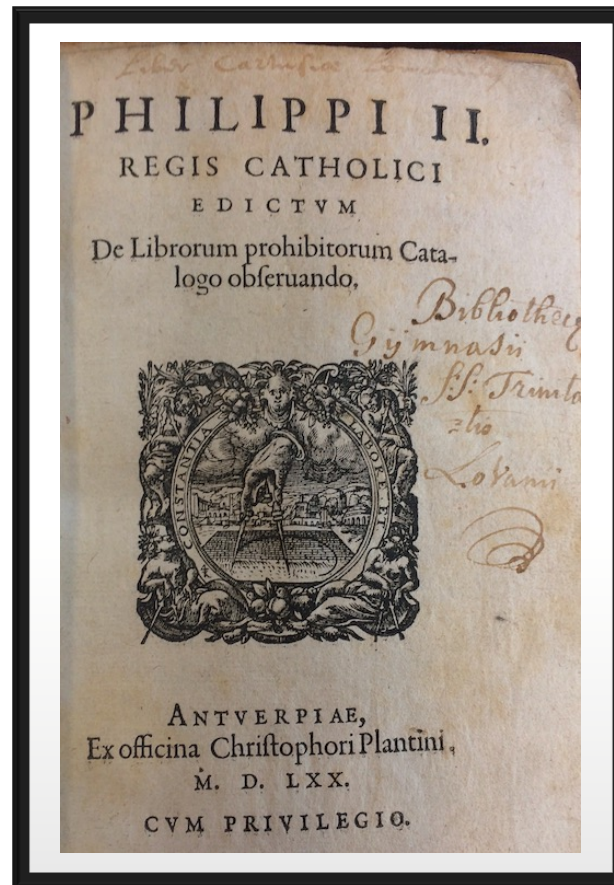


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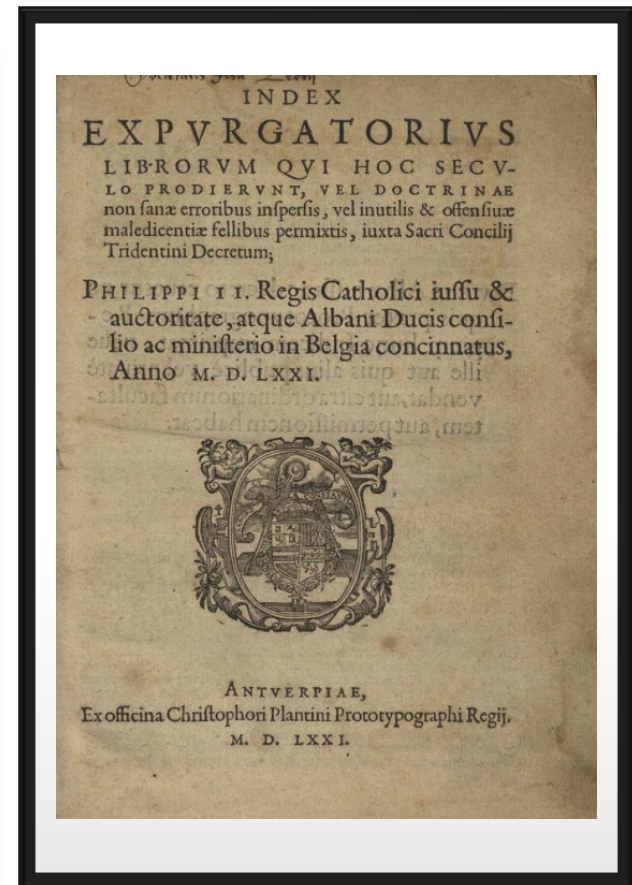
Council of Troubles (1567-1576) ➡ Three indexes (Antwerp)



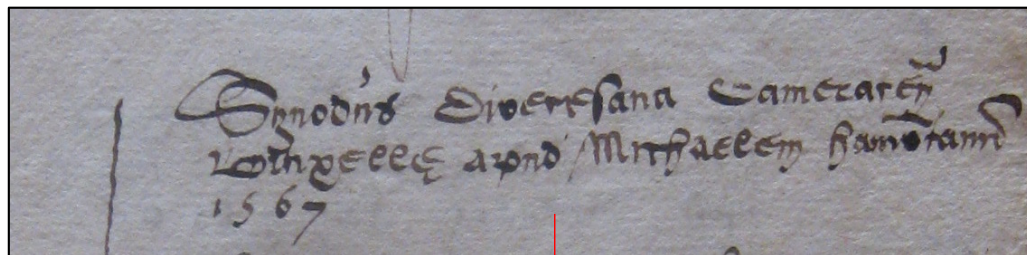
