- Identification with characters for better adherence




- Visual power (images show what cannot be said)










































TRANSDISCIPLINARITY OF THE MEDICAL HUMANITIES




- Improve soft skills (empathy, etc.)

- Cathartic effect to reflect on one's own practices or difficulties




- Facilitating health literacy




Development and evaluation of a pedagogical module on bipolarity to develop soft skills in pharmacy students

- Increased empathy score after reading the graphic novel
- 90% of students feel more able to understand and manage a bipolar patient
- >90% of students recommend this type of activity and think it has been useful for their future practice
- "It's a form of active learning, because we're not just learning, we're also making an emotional connection. It's more concrete, and the emotional component really helps with memorization. Discussing it afterwards was refreshing, because it's not the typical type of pedagogy we experience at university. »
