

MESSINA AS CONFERENCE SITE

Messina, a port city on the famous Strait of Messina, is located in the North-East corner of Sicily, just opposite the Italian mainland. The city was founded by the Greeks in the 8th century BC. In the Middle Ages, the port was of great importance and the city flourished until the XVII century as can be seen from the many interesting buildings. In June 1955, Messina was the location of the Messina Conference of Western European foreign ministers which led to the creation of the European Economic Community. Messina is near many interesting localities from the historical, cultural and tourist points of view, such as Taormina, Siracusa and Catania. The University of Messina, founded in 1548, and its Engineering Faculty built in a modern architectural style will host, for the first time, the NAV Conference on Ship and Shipping Research.


