## **Conversion from Excel into Aleph sequential**

This working paper summarizes in eight steps the way we convert an Excel file into Aleph sequential in order to import records with manage-18. This is a free translation and an expanded version of slides 25-27 from a presentation hold at the annual meeting of the ACEF (*Association des clients d'Ex-Libris France*) on June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2008.

Note that next to this eight-step procedure we always use fix\_doc\_do\_file\_08 to correct or complete our data as much as we can. No extra programming is needed. Most of this procedure has been developed by Paul Thirion (paul.thirion@ulg.ac.be).

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## (1) Start from your xls file:

- a) Try to have uniform contents (print books only or e-books only or serials only...  $\rightarrow$  easier for batch processes).
- b) Your data must be as correct as possible.

<u>NB</u> : Tips to make your file more readable:

- a) Call each column with the appropriate Marc field (or subfield) code or with a clear name (title, author, URL...).
- b) Put the columns in the order you prefer.
